Thank you to those parents who took the time to complete our questionnaire a few weeks ago. I have detailed the responses below, and would like to highlight the following points:

- It is pleasing to see that the vast majority of you feel incredibly positive about your child's experiences at school.
- Where parents indicate a 'don't know', this is not a negative response. In fact when referring to bullying, we see that as a positive, as it shows that we have very few incidences which would concern a child, or parent.
- I have taken on board responses regarding after-school activities, and we have started to look at extending the provision across the year groups for next academic year.
