Red Badge : Your child is expected to have achieved all of the following statements by the end of Reception.

I can come into class by myself; put my coat on my peg and put my book bag in my tray.	
I hand in my own home-learning to the teacher.	
I can sit on the carpet with others and I can show that I am ready to listen.	
I take care of toys and other items in the classroom.	
I can hold and use a pencil correctly.	
I can write my own surname, starting with a capital letter, eg Smith	
I can describe events from the past and in the future; 'I <u>went</u> to my nan's house'. 'I <u>am going</u> to the park after school'.	
I can share my news with others; I can remember the events in the right order.	
I know all my Phase 2 sounds: s a t p l n m d g o c k e u r h b f ff l ll ss j v w x y z	
I can write all the Phase 2 sounds correctly; forming their shape correctly.	
I can read the tricky words; 'and', 'to', 'no', 'go', 'I', 'the', 'he', 'she', 'we', 'me', 'be', 'was', 'my', 'you', 'all', 'are', 'her'.	
I can spell the tricky words; 'and', 'to', 'no', 'go', 'I', 'the', 'he', 'she', 'we', 'me', 'be', 'was', 'my', 'you', 'all', 'are', 'her'	
I can recognise Phase 3 sounds; 'qu', 'ch', 'sh', 'th', 'ng', 'ai', 'ee', 'igh', 'oa', 'oo', 'are', 'or', 'ur', 'ow', 'oi', 'ear', 'air', 'ure', 'er'.	
I can recognise numbers to 20.	
I can order numbers to 20.	
I can say 1 more or 1 less than numbers to at least 10.	
I can copy and continue a 2 colour repeating pattern.	
I can add and subtract 2 single digit numbers eg 5 + 4 =	
I can read and understand simple sentences, eg 'The dog ran to the cat'.	
I can write a sentence that others can read.	
I can use capital letters and full stops when writing a sentence.	
I can use finger spaces in my writing.	
When listening to a story, that is read to me (not dvd), I can predict what might happen next.	
I can organise myself to be ready to learn; for example, I know where to get a pencil and paper from without an adult helping me.	
I am in the habit of reading regularly at home and learning my sounds, at least 2 nights each week.
