Regular Items/Terms of Reference:

- Pupil achievement including progress of groups of learners
- Monitor and review the school's priorities (SDP) and the progress made against these priorities
- Monitor student progress and areas affecting learning by attending PPMs
- INSET programme for the term and all staff's CPD
- Monitor and review the effectiveness of the school curriculum on standards and outcomes for children – Maths, English, Science, R.E, SEN
- Review and monitor the development of school self-evaluation
- Monitor, review and receive reports for curriculum development
- Review the outcomes of the monitoring programme and receive reports of any monitoring and related actions e.g. presentations
- Review curriculum subject policies
- Reports of collaborative work and impact
- Monitor the effectiveness of Pupil Premium spend

Autumn Term:

- Previous year's attainment and progress compared to local and national data (RAISEonline)
- Target setting
- Review Terms of reference for the committee
- Quality of teaching

Spring Term:

- Ensure that a comprehensive assessment programme, including all statutory test and examinations are planned to be implemented fairly, effectively and in accordance with government guidelines.

Summer Term:

- Review initial known outcomes of statutory assessments/tests for Foundation Stage, KS1 and KS2
- Agree the draft priorities for the next SDP
- Review the School Prospectus
- Review the Staff handbook
