Overarching Focus: Read aloud to build accuracy, fluency and confidence in word reading and read for pleasure.

Word Reading

I can read Year 3 Spelling Challenge 1 words.

I can read a range of texts fluently and accurately, using a variety of strategies.

I can explore meanings using my knowledge of root words, prefixes etc.

I am beginning to read aloud and perform texts confidently.

Comprehension

I can discuss how characters relate to each other.

I can use a dictionary to check the meaning of new words I have read.

I can find and record information from non-fiction books.

I can predict what might happen using the text.

I can recognise similarities and differences between texts, eg plot, topic, author, characters.

I know which words are essential to a sentence to make it make sense.

I can use punctuation to help with expression.

I can identify how punctuation helps me to understand texts.

I can devise questions to help me to understand more about texts.

I can identify words and phrases that capture interest/imagination.

I can identify different ways information is presented.

I can infer characters' feelings, thoughts and motives.

I can predict using inference as above.

I can discuss books using booktalk terminology eg plot, character, vocabulary, mood, layout...

I can identify main ideas from paragraphs and summarise key points.

I can use clues from dialogue, action and description to establish meaning.
